Re: Proposed Waiting Restrictions on Beech Bank and Church Walk

As your local County Councillor I am writing to you with regards to parking issues in the above areas. I would like to make sure that all residents have the opportunity to put their views forward whilst highlighting any areas of concern you may have.

We are looking to consult with members of the community regarding the proposed waiting restrictions on the following streets:

- **Beech Bank** - On Beech Bank keep clear markings have been implemented to remove parking which obstruct the junction of Sea View and Beech Bank as the road width is very narrow. Parking stops larger vehicles from being able to make the turn. It is proposed to replace the existing keep clear markings with double yellow lines and also proposed to include an additional short length at the junction to improve turning movements. The lengths are proposed to keep displaced parking to a minimum.
- **Church Walk** - Concerns have been raised by residents in the area regarding parking on Church Walk near to the Church. Church Walk becomes extremely narrow and traffic is already restricted to travel in one direction south to north as it is not wide enough for two way traffic. Parking of vehicles when there are events on both at the school and church obstruct both the footway and carriageway for all road users.

To remedy this and to facilitate through traffic, double yellow lines are proposed both sides of the road over the entire length of the narrowest part as shown on the attached plan.

A plan of this area is enclosed over the page along with a feedback sheet where you can give details of any issues you may have with the proposals as well as possible solutions. I would be grateful if you could complete this and return it to us by **3rd February 2012**.

If you prefer to discuss this in person, you are welcome to come along to a Community Drop In session from **3.30pm – 6:30pm on Tuesday 24th January at the Ulverston Parish Centre, Church Walk**.
