

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTH LAKELAND AREA)
(CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2002)
VARIATION ORDER (KENDAL) 20><

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the proposed Order will be to make the following changes to the traffic restrictions in Kendal: -
 - (a) Impose “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on parts of the following roads: -

Back Lound Street, Castle Park, Castle Road, Fletcher Drive, Ford Terrace, Garden Mews, Garden Road, Hawesmead Avenue, Hawesmead Drive, Natland road, Parr Street/Sunnywise, Parkside Road, Queen Katherine’s Street, Romney Road, Shap Road and South Road.
 - (b) Impose “Parking Places, Waiting Limited, 8 am – 6 pm, Full Week, Waiting Limited to 1 Hour, Return Prohibited within 1 Hour” on parts of Back Lound Street, Garden Road, Lound Street, Parkside Road and Queen Katherine Street;

Residents of new Zone G (All of Garden Road (including Netherdene), all of Garden Street, Nos 20- 70 (even nos only) of Lound road, all of Lound Street and Nos 3 – 13 (odd nos only) of Parkside Road) will be exempt from the restrictions on Back Lound street, Garden Road, Lound Street and Parkside Road.

Residents of both sides of Queen Katherine Street and Nos. 9-13 Aynam Road will be exempt from the restrictions on Queen Katherine Street.
 - (c) Amend Zone F so that it will now encompass: -

Nos 1 – 6 Aynam Place, No. 78 Aynam Road, No. 2 Lound Road, all of Nether Street and all of Wilson Street;
 - (d) Impose “Parking Place, Limited Waiting, 8.00 am – 10.00 pm, Full Week, Waiting Limited to 1 Hour, Return Prohibited within 1 Hour”, on parts of Natland Road.

Residents of Zone D will be exempt from the restrictions in Natland Road.
 - (e) Amend Zone D so that it will now encompass: -

Nos 2 – 82 and 3-53 Natland Road, all of Rinkfield, all of Burland Grove and No. 41 Burton Road.
 - (f) Impose “Restricted Waiting, 8 am – 6 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, Waiting Limited to 2 Hours, Return Prohibited within 2 Hours” on parts of South Road;
 - (g) Impose “No Waiting, 8 am – 6 pm, Full Week” on part of Parkside Road and Romney Road;
 - (h) Impose “No Entry” for vehicles proceeding southbound in South Road at a point 84 metres north of the centre of its junction with West Street; and

- (i) Remove the existing restrictions on site to accommodate the proposals detailed above. This will include the consolidation and revocation of The County of Cumbria (South Road, Kendal) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order 2004.

Full details of the proposed Order, together with plans showing the lengths of road concerned, and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the offices of Cumbria Highways, County Offices, Kendal and at the offices of the undersigned during normal working hours.
